Music Row is a unique area that has produced some of the world's greatest music for over 60 years. Now this area that is the heart of Nashville's worldwide recognition as Music City is in danger of being being lost forever.

Since 2013, 43 buildings with music industry connections have been demolished – most to make way for apartment buildings. Now five buildings on 16th Avenue, including Bobby's Idle Hour, are threatened with demolition. The buildings – 1022, 1024, 1026, 1028 and 1030 – have housed music industry businesses for decades.
